

# COVID-19 Protocol Matrix for Unvaccinated Individuals and Individuals that Decline to State Their Vaccination Status

*THIS PROTOCOL MATRIX DOES NOT APPLY TO FULLY VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS*

Level 2	Activities involve limited interactions with others. Work areas are either outside or in buildings / work areas where there is adequate space to maintain physical distancing requirements. Level 3	Brief activities where physical distancing is not feasible, or the physical constraints of the job require two or more people be present.  <b>No face-to-face work</b>	Contact (less than six feet) with any single individual for no period that is greater than 10 total minutes per hour, contact with a single individual no more than 30 total minutes in a day, and no more than 60 total minutes of Level 3 work in a day. *	Face-coverings are required per the <a href="#">SLAC Face Covering Requirements</a>	COVID-19 Training for Onsite SLAC Employees ( <a href="#">Course 100R</a> ); Onsite Briefing with ESH Coordinator or other responsible person <i>or</i> SLAC COVID-19 Training for Onsite Contractors ( <a href="#">Course 376R</a> )	Follow recommended best practices	Supervisor and ESH Coordinator
Level 4	Activities that require two or more people working within 6' of each other for more than 10 minutes in an hour or more than 30 minutes in a day.	Contact (less than six feet) with any single individual for a period of time greater than thirty total minutes in a day, and/or contact with a single individual that is greater than 10 total minutes total contact per hour. **	Use of N95 respirators is required	Respiratory Protection Training ( <a href="#">Course 174</a> or <a href="#">241</a> )  COVID-19 Training for Onsite SLAC Employees ( <a href="#">Course 100R</a> ); Onsite Briefing with ESH Coordinator or other responsible person <i>or</i> SLAC COVID-19 Training for Onsite Contractors ( <a href="#">Course 376R</a> )	Follow recommended best practices	Supervisor and ESH Coordinator

\* **Level 3 work:** A worker can work within 6' of any other worker(s) for no longer than 10 total minutes per hour. Workers can also perform no more than 30 total minutes with any single individual in a day. A worker cannot perform more than 60 total minutes of Level 3 work per day independent of whom that work is with. For example: Worker A works within 6' of worker B installing a piece of equipment (task 1). Worker A cannot work within 6' of worker B until an hour has passed after task 1 is completed. However, worker A can work with Worker C (Task 2) within the same hour as worker B. Worker A can also work with worker D (task 3) within the same hour as worker B and C. Worker A cannot work more than 30 minutes in a day with Worker B, C or D. The worker cannot perform more than 60 minutes of Level 3 work independent of whom that work is with.

\*\* **Level 4 work:** A worker that works within 6' of any other worker(s) for longer than 10 total minutes in an hour or longer than 30 minutes in a day. For Example: Worker A, B, C and D will need to be within 6' of each other to install a piece of equipment (Task 1). Task 1 will take 35 minutes. Worker A, B, C and D would need to follow Level 4 protocols. If worker A, B, C and/or D need to be within 6' of each other (together or separately) at any time later in the day (task 2) protocols would be defined by what level of work task 2 is defined as (level 3 or level 4).
